

Residency Determination Service (RDS) Reconsideration and Appeal Process

A student may request an appeal **within 10 calendar days of determination.** After requesting the appeal, the student has 25 days to submit the request with all documentation. There is an option of reconsideration and two types of appeal.

Reconsideration

- Allows student to change info about himself, parents/legal guardians, and/or spouse
- Complete this step if:
 - Incomplete information or missing data
 - Failure to submit required documents on time
- Error while entering information
- Change in your personal/living situation

RDS Appeal

- 1) Request the RDS Appeal Online (must request within 10 days)
- 2) Submit additional information and documentation about student, parents/legal guardians or spouse to support claim
- 3) Submit appeal request

*Additional documentation and appeal request must both be submitted within 25 days

4) Answer calls, emails, and/or meet face-to-face (or via technology) to answer any questions and review appeal

SEAA Appeal

- Final administrative step in the residency process
- Cannot be completed before RDS Appeal
- No additional documentation or information is permitted
- Conducted by a statewide committee comprised of representatives from:
 - The North Carolina Community College System
 - North Carolina Independent Colleges and Universities
 - State Education Assistance Authority
 - The University of North Carolina System
